

## COOKIES POLICY

### What are cookies?

In English, the term "cookie" means cookie, but in the field of web browsing, a "cookie" is something else entirely.

When you access our website, a small amount of text called a "cookie" is stored in your device's browser. This text contains various information about your browsing, habits, preferences, content customizations, etc.

There are other technologies that work in a similar way and are also used to collect data about your browsing activity. We will call all these technologies "cookies" together.

The specific uses we make of these technologies are described in this document.

### What are cookies used for on this website [www.ibizaroyalapartments.com](http://www.ibizaroyalapartments.com)?

Cookies are an essential part of how our website works. The main objective of our cookies is to improve your browsing experience. For example, to remember your preferences (language, Country, etc.) During navigation and on future visits. The information collected in cookies also allows us to improve the website, adapt it to your interests as a user; speed up the searches you carry out, etc.

In certain cases, if we have obtained your prior informed consent, we may use cookies for other uses, such as, for example, to obtain information that allows us to show you advertising based on the analysis of your browsing habits.

### What are cookies NOT used for on this website [www.ibizaroyalapartments.com](http://www.ibizaroyalapartments.com)?

Sensitive personally identifiable information such as your name, address, your password, etc ... is not stored in the cookies we use.

### Who uses the information stored in cookies?

The information stored in the cookies on our website is used exclusively by us, with the exception of those identified below as 'third-party cookies', which are used and managed by external entities that provide us with services that improve the user experience. For example, the statistics that are collected on the number of visits, the content that is most liked, etc. ... that GOOGLE ANALYTICS manages.

Third-party cookies are also often used to guarantee payment operations made through the web.

### How can I avoid the use of cookies on this website?

If you prefer to avoid the use of cookies, you can REJECT their use or you can CONFIGURE the ones you want to avoid and the ones you allow to use (in this document we give you extended information regarding each type of cookie, its purpose, recipient, temporality, etc. ...).

If you have accepted them, we will not ask you again unless you delete the cookies on your device as indicated in the next section.

If you want to revoke the consent, you will have to delete the cookies and configure them again.

### How do I disable and eliminate the use of cookies?

To restrict, block or delete cookies from this website (and those used by third parties) you can do so, at any time, by modifying your browser settings. Keep in mind that this configuration is different in each browser, although it is common to find the cookie settings in the menu 'Preferences' 'Tools' "Options" and then in "Privacy and Security "or" delete navigation data ", etc. ...

For more details on the configuration of cookies in each browser, you can consult its 'Help' menu.

### What types of cookies are used on this website?

On our website we use those indicated at continuation:

- Own cookies:

Are those that are sent to the user's terminal equipment from a computer or domain managed by the publisher itself and from which the service requested by the user is provided.

- Third-party cookies:

Are those that are sent to the user's terminal equipment from a computer or domain that is not managed by the editor, but by another entity that processes the data obtained through cookies.

In the event that cookies are served from a computer or domain managed by the publisher himself, but the information collected through them is managed by a third party, they cannot be considered as own cookies if the third party uses them for its own purposes. (for example, the improvement of the services it provides or the provision of advertising services in favour of other Entities).

#### ACCORDING TO ITS PURPOSE

- Technical cookies:

Are those necessary for navigation and the proper functioning of our website, such as, for example, controlling traffic and data communication, identifying the session, accessing restricted access parts, carrying out the reservation process for an apartment, managing payment, control fraud linked to the security of the service, use security elements during navigation, store content for the dissemination of videos or sound, enable dynamic content (for example, animation of loading a text or image) or share content through social networks.

- Analysis cookies:

They allow quantifying the number of users and thus carrying out the statistical measurement and analysis of the use that users make of the service offered. For this, your browsing on our website is analysed in order to improve the offer of products or services that we offer you.

- Preference or customization cookies:

Are those that allow the user to remember information so that the user accesses the service with certain characteristics that can differentiate their experience from that of other users, such as, for example, the language, the number of results to show when the user performs a search, the appearance or Content of the service depending on the type of browser through which the user accesses the service or the region from which the service is accessed, etc.

#### ACCORDING TO THE PERIOD OF TIME THEY REMAIN ACTIVATED

- Session cookies:

Are those designed to collect and store data while the user accesses a web page. They are usually used to store information that is only interested in keeping for the provision of the service requested by the user on a single occasion and They disappear at the end of the session.

- Persistent cookies:

Are those in which the data is still stored in the terminal and can be accessed and processed during a period defined by the person responsible for the cookie, which can range from a few minutes to several years. In this regard, it must be specifically assessed whether the use of persistent cookies is necessary, since the risks to privacy could be reduced through the use of session cookies. In any case, when persistent cookies are installed, it is recommended to reduce their temporary duration to the minimum necessary according to the purpose of their use. For these purposes, Opinion 4/2012 of the WG29 indicated that for a cookie to be exempt from the duty of informed consent, its expiration must be related to its purpose. Because of this, session cookies are much more likely to be considered exceptions than persistent cookies.

Details of cookies used on this website:

##### Technical cookies (essential)

###### User identification

They are used to identify the user, contain technical session data, connection timeout, etc.

###### Session Own

###### Navigation status

They are used to identify in which navigation state the find the user: first page, first access, etc.

###### User selections

They are used to save the values that have been selected by the user: language, currency...

###### Session Own

###### Favourites and latest selections

They allow remembering the user's favourite selections or the last selections

###### Persistent Own

They store information about the basket and the user's identification data linked to it.

They allow managing domain changes between secure (http) and non-secure (https)

Purchase device

They allow offering sufficient guarantees for making purchases. At no time do they include sensitive information such as card details.

Google analytics

They allow tracking using the Google Analytics tool, which is a service provided by Google to obtain information on user access to the web: number of times the user visits the web, dates of first and last visit, duration of visits, from which page you accessed the web, etc. The information generated by the cookie, about the use of the web, will be directly transmitted and filed by Google Inc (company based in the USA). The configuration of these cookies is default by the service offered by Google, so we suggest that you consult the privacy policy of Google Analytics.
